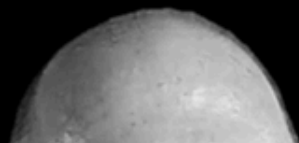

Goal: Zero-Emissions Industry on Earth

one's own terms than re-actively respond to laws and rules. It's very different than environmental progress made from the 1960's-2010's (statutory and rules based).

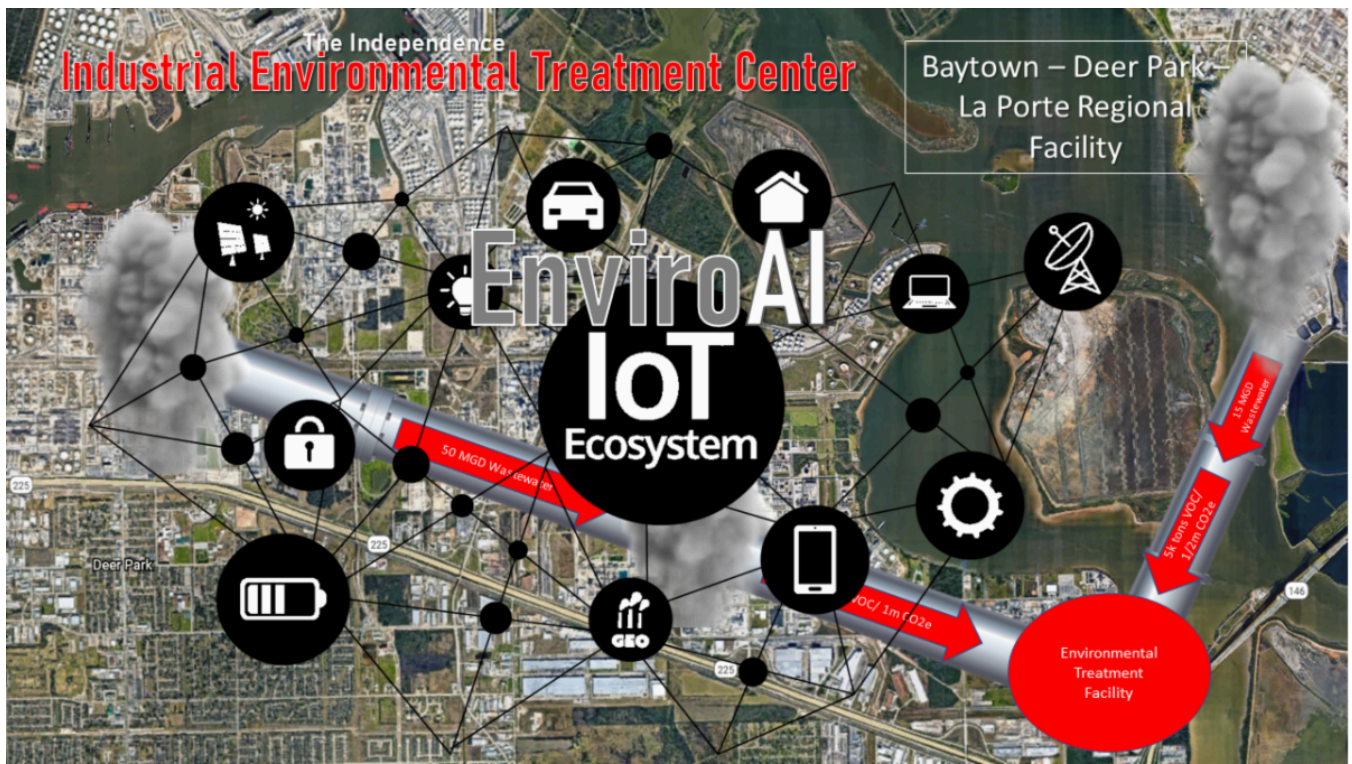
Beyond compliance. Beyond regulation. Beyond wonderful.

My plan, like Musk's and Bezos', is also in its early implementation stages:



A quantum AI environmental protection system

- Petabytes of environmental textual data being scraped and machine learning applied
- Remote sensing systems integrated into AI data gathering and intelligence analysis platform (automated drones, open-path FTIR, fixed optical gas imaging, satellites)



The world's largest industrial emissions reduction project

- Service contracts with 3 petrochemical companies under negotiation
- Option on 450 acre industrial tract secured and due diligence completed
