# I just published a new essay

I just published a new essay: "Reframing the Environmental Movement." The central argument is simple: the environmental movement has spent 50 years operating from a paradigm built in the 1960s and 70s ... one that correctly identified human-caused damage, but quietly assumed that "nature without us" is stable and safe.
