I keep training my 3 boys to take risk. The bigger the better. Physical, spiritual, emotional, vocational. Risk. Risk. Risk.

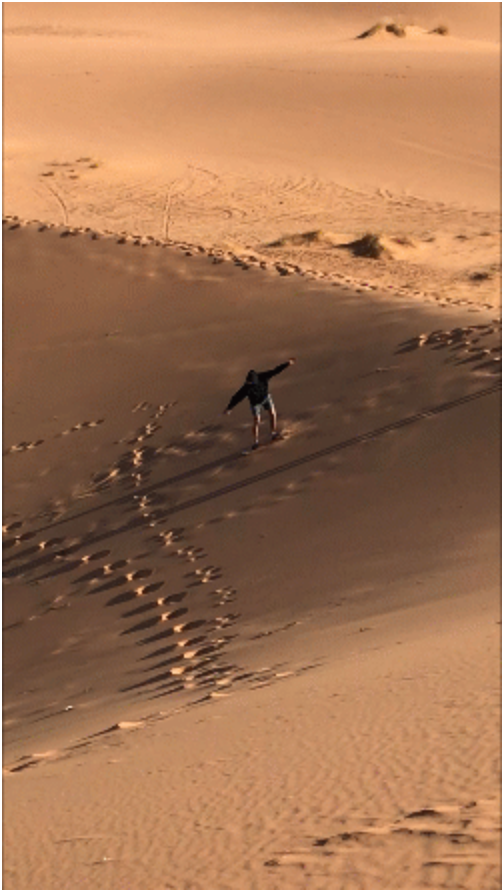
